SUBJECT: Expired License, Bristol-Myers Company, Hillside, New Jersey

On October 5, 1984, a licensee representative, Dr. S. Mark Henry, Manager of Clinical Research Services, was contacted and informed that License No. 29-01894-01 had expired on July 31, 1984, and that no renewal application had been received. The licensee representative explained that they have received and possessed licensed material, but now possess no licensed material and wish to have the license terminated. Licensed material was disposed of by transfer to Teledyne Isotopes, Inc. This was confirmed in the license's letter dated May 30, 1985.

Based on a review of the information supplied by the licensee and a review of the type and form of material authorized by the license, a close out survey by the licensee is required. A survey dated June 15, 1983, was received with the licensee's letter dated March 13, 1985, and demonstrates that the facility meets the "Guidelines for Release of Facilities ...". A close out survey by Region I is not required.

Based on the above information, we have retired License No. 29-01894-01. Please remove it from your active shelves.
