Dear Sir or Madame:

Upon a careful rereading the cover letter of my Materials License, (48-26708-01, I note that I overlooked a condition stated in the cover letter: namely that I not possess and use materials authorized by the license before notifying the U.S. NRC that activities authorized by the license will be initiated. Upon first reading of the license, I mistakenly believed that I could immediately receive the authorized radionuclides and could start survey instrument calibration once I had complied with condition 20 of the license :["Before initiation of a survey instrument calibration program, radiation surveys shall be performed in accordance with the following..."]. This latter condition was met in a letter I sent to the commission dated June 20, 1996.

This is to formally notify you that the first materials authorized in items 6, 7, and 8 on the license arrived on site June 4, 1996, and calibration activities authorized by the license commenced on August 22, 1996. I regret this failure to observe the notification requirement and trust this letter will put me in good stead with the NRC.
