Dear Mr. Bauser:

In connection with recent activities of the more violent terrorist groups such as occurred recently at Munich, the Atomic Energy Commission and the Department of Defense have directed their field personnel to take security and alert precautions appropriate for this kind of threat. We have also requested the intelligence community to be especially alert to any pertinent information.

In the case of AEC, this alert extends to the weapons, nuclear materials production, and naval reactors programs and to appropriate licensees on the Regulatory side.
