FEDERAL EMERGENCY PLAN D,  
REVISED MARCH 1970

The subject plan prescribes major Federal policies and actions and provides implementing documents that will be required by the Federal Government during and after a crippling nuclear attack on the United States. Plan D gives uniform guidance to the departments and agencies concerned with planning for postattack activities.

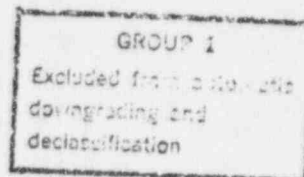
Limited distribution of the current Plan D is being made at this time by the Office of Emergency Preparedness (OEP). Copies are available for reference and review by concerned AEC Headquarters personnel in the Procurement Assistance and Mobilization Planning Branch of the Division of Contracts and will be available under emergency conditions at the Emergency Relocation Center-Headquarters (ERC-H) and at the alternate storage site for AEC vital records at the Special Facilities Division of OEP. Copies also are being provided for retention in the General Manager's office and to Managers of Operations Offices.

Wider distribution was permitted by OEP of the previous edition of Plan D, with its Annexes A and B, dated February 1968. Copies were furnished the addressees by secret memorandum dated June 11, 1968, subject "Federal Emergency Plan D," signed by J. A. Derry, Director, Division of Construction, HQ. These copies, including Annexes A and B, are now superseded and should be destroyed according to applicable security regulations.

Existing AEC guidelines on emergency planning, such as Manual Chapters in the 0600 series, are under continuous review to insure provision for policies and actions such as those in Plan D. The revisions in the current edition of Plan D do not affect AEC's emergency responsibilities or planning.

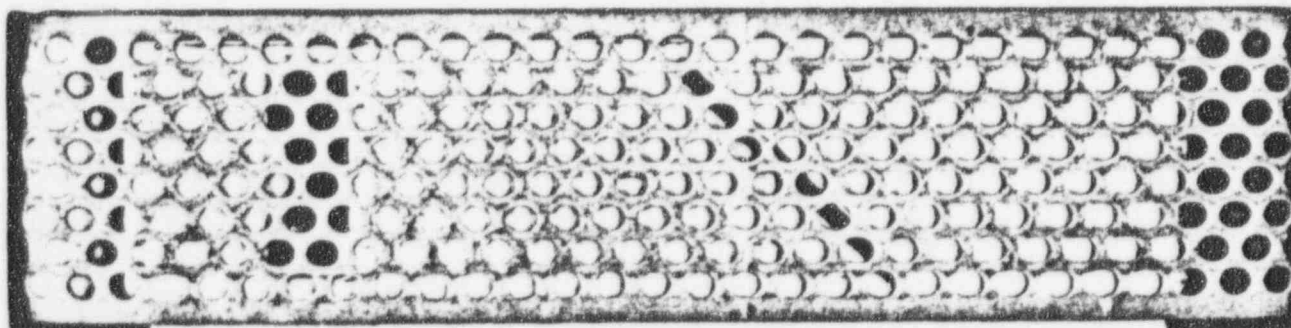
