Dear Mr. Hockersmith:

Dr. Martin of your office has informed me that a license application has been filed with EFC by Coleman Instruments, Inc., Maywood, Illinois, requesting authority to export a fluorophotometer to Verimax, Warsaw, Poland, for use in indicating vitamins in food products. Dr. Miller asked for AEC comments on this application, which bears EFC Case No. 209326.

This item is on Annex D (Atomic Energy List) of International List I. It is on Category B, Title I, of the Battle Act. Since there appears to be no atomic energy use indicated for the use of this particular instrument in Poland there is no basis for considering any policy implications relating to the United States supporting a Polish atomic energy program. In view of these circumstances, and since the proposed use of the instrument seems to be consistent with existing U. S. licensing policy toward Poland, there is no AEC objection to approval of this application.
