for the Penetration Room Ventilation System (PRVS)  
Technical Specification Change # 95-04

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.90, Attachment 1 provides a proposed amendment to the Oconee Nuclear Station (ONS) Facility Operating Licenses and Technical Specifications. This proposed amendment revises the Technical Specifications to reduce the allowable reactor building volume leakage rate per day limit to permit relaxation of certain requirements for operability of the PRVS System and is being submitted to resolve the issues associated with Deviation 94-24-04. UFSAR Chapters 2, 3, 6, 9, and 15 will need to be revised for this proposed amendment.

Attachment 2 is a markup of the current Technical Specifications which identifies the added and deleted portions of text. Attachment 3 and the revised Bases of the Technical Specifications provide the supporting technical justification.

The attached proposed amendment has no significant hazards considerations. Attachments 4 and 5 provide the No Significant Hazards Consideration Evaluation and Environmental Impacts Statement, respectively.

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
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The Nuclear Safety Review Board and the ONS Plant Operations Review Committee have reviewed and approved this proposed Technical Specification amendment.



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
