Dear Ms. Cynthia Penderson:

This letter is in response to the NRC inspection conducted at Memorial Hospital on September 24, 1996. In response to the violation of 10 CFR 35.2 regarding a written directive for administration of Iodine 125 or Iodine 131 in quantities greater than 30 microcuries, we would like to assure you that the appropriate corrective action has been taken.

In accordance with 10 CFR 35.2 a written directive shall be provided prior to administration of Iodine 125 or Iodine 131 in quantities greater than 30 microcuries. This written directive shall contain the specific patient, date and dosage to be administered and signed by the authorized user. This written directive shall be placed in the QMP file as well as a copy in the patients Nuclear Medicine examination file. This action is and has been in effect as of September 24, 1996, the date of the NRC inspection.

We also would like to insure the NRC that we are continuously striving to adhere to all of the NRC regulations in regards to the operation and management of radioactive materials.
