Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit NOs. 1, 2, and 3
On-shift Dose Assessment Capability

The NCR's Final Emergency Preparedness Position (EPSOM) regarding Onshift Dose Assessment, EPPOS No. 3, clarified the staff's position regarding the need for control room personnel to perform dose assessments. Specifically, EPPOS No. 3 states that "... licensees must retain the capability to perform dose assessment using effluent release information and real-time meteorology at all times." Accordingly, this letter is to inform you that Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) is taking the following actions prior to restart of any of the Millstone units:

- Selected on-shift personnel will be trained to perform dose assessments using real-time meteorological and effluent monitor data; and
- The Millstone Nuclear Power Station Emergency Plan will be revised to indicate that on-shift staffing of the Station Emergency Response Organization will include personnel to perform dose assessments.
