SUBJECT: RECEIPT OF PUNCTURED WASTE OIL DRUM IN WASHINGTON STATE

The licensee reports that it was notified on August 18, 1985 by the State of Washington that one drum of solidified waste oil received at the U. S. Ecology burial site arrived with a puncture near the lower ring. The puncture appeared to be a cut in the side of the drum, approximately one inch in length. No leakage of any material occurred.

The licensee has dispatched a representative to the State of Washington site. The State has suspended the Hatch burial permit unit corrective actions to prevent recurrence of the incident have been reviewed and approved.

Region II will conduct a routine followup.

The State of Georgia has been informed.

Region V has also been informed.
