Subject: Updating of NRC Incoming Correspondence and Signature Authorization
for Senior Management Changes

Dear Sir:

Florida Power Corporation (FPC) is in the process of making senior management organizational changes which affect the standard recipients of incoming NRC correspondence, and those authorized to sign outgoing correspondence for Crystal River Unit 3 (CR-3). This correspondence is provided to request changes to your service list, and to inform you from whom you can expect to receive docketed items.

The changes include the appointments of Mr. Roy A. Anderson to Senior Vice President, Nuclear Operations, Mr. John P. Cowan to Vice President, Nuclear Production, Mr. John J. Holden to Director, Nuclear Engineering and Projects, and Mr. David F. Kunsemiller to Director, Nuclear Operations Site Support.

Mr. Anderson will assume full responsibility for the CR-3 nuclear plant on March 3, 1997. He brings to FPC extensive experience in nuclear management including serving as Senior Vice President with Carolina Power and Light (CP&L), and restart experience at the CP&L Brunswick Nuclear Station. Mr. Cowan assumed the position of Vice President, Nuclear Production on February 3, 1997. He previously worked with Mr. Anderson during the restart of Brunswick and more recently was a leader of the restart team at Northeast Utilities' Millstone station. 1/0

Mr. Holden assumed the position of Director, Nuclear Engineering and Projects on January 27, 1997. His recent experience includes Assistant Plant General Manager at Salem Units 1&2, and Manager, Design Engineering at Brunswick Nuclear Station. Mr. Kunsemiller assumed the position of Director, Nuclear Operations Site Support on February 3, 1997. His experience includes such diverse areas as: nuclear


