SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR WITHHOLDING INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC DISCLOSURE, BEAVER  
VALLEY POWER STATION, UNIT NOS. 1 AND 2

Dear Mr. Cross:

By letter dated August 27, 1996, you submitted information which you stated contained "personnel and medical files" and requested that the letter be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790(a)(6).

The NRC staff has reviewed your August 27, 1996, letter and the criteria of 10 CFR 2.790(a)(6). On the basis of our review, the NRC staff has determined that the second paragraph of your August 27, 1996, letter contains personnel and medical files. Therefore, the contents of the second paragraph of your August 27, 1996, letter will be withheld from public disclosure, pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790(a)(6) and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.

Within 30 days from the receipt of this letter, a copy of your August 27, 1996, letter, with the second paragraph redacted, will be placed in the Public Document Room. If, within thirty (30) days of the receipt of this letter, you request withdrawal of the documents in accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(c), your request will be considered in light of applicable statutes and regulations and a determination made whether the documents will be withheld from public disclosure and returned to you.

Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents. If the need arises, we may send copies of this information to our consultants working in this area. We will, of course, ensure that the consultants have signed the appropriate agreements for handling privacy information.

If the basis for withholding this information from public inspection should change in the future, such that the information could then be made available for public inspection, you should promptly notify the NRC. You should also understand that the NRC may have cause to review this determination in the

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future, for example, if the scope of a Freedom of Information Act request includes your information. In all review situations, if the NRC makes a determination adverse to the above, you will be notified in advance of any public disclosure.

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
