
Gentlemen:

Your letter dated June 20, 1985 (2CNA068503) provided AP&L with a Safety Evaluation Report (SER) concerning the Inservice Testing Program (IST) for Arkansas Nuclear One - Unit Two (ANO-2).

Based on the results of your review, NRC determined that all relief requests except the one pertaining to stroke timing of the emergency feedwater pump turbine governor valve should be granted. Additionally, NRC determined that the scope of the ANO-2 IST Program should be expanded to include certain pumps and valves in the diesel generator auxiliary system. You requested our response addressing this subject within 60 days of the date of your letter.

Due to the level of review necessary to make a thorough and adequate response to your SER, we request an extension to September 30, 1985 to make our response. This request has been discussed with the ANO-2 NRR Project Manager.
