SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION  
(NRC Investigative Report No. 1-96-013)

Dear Mr. Muszynski:

This refers to your letter dated January 17, 1997, in response to our letter dated December 20, 1996. Our letter, dated December 20, 1996, forwarded to you a Notice of Violation for the falsification of a dose calibrator constancy record in November 1995.

In your letter dated January 17, 1997, you denied violating any NRC regulations, stating that you accurately performed the dose calibrator constancy check during the day in question. In your letter, you also stated that you have consistently complied with all NRC regulations that were given to you by the Radiation Safety Officer, and committed to comply with all required NRC regulations in the future. Notwithstanding your denial, after careful examination of the additional information you provided in your January 17, 1997 letter, and in coordination with the Director of Enforcement, the NRC maintains that the NRC investigation supports the violation enclosed with our December 20, 1996 letter. Therefore, the violation remains as cited in our December 20, 1996 letter.

Your letter also stated that the Radiation Safety Officer did not always provide you with the pertinent NRC regulations. The licensee is required to provide radiation safety training to all employees involved in radiological operations. During the previous inspection at New Britain Hospital, no violations of radiological safety training were identified. However, radiological safety training, and dissemination of regulatory information, including regulations relevant to the program operations, will be examined during a future NRC inspection of the facility.

No response to this letter is required. In accordance with Section 2.790 of NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the Public Document Room (PDR).

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
