
The purpose of this letter is to announce a Maintenance Rule Baseline Team Inspection at your Waterford 3 reactor facility. The inspection is scheduled for January 27-31, 1996. Mr. John E. Whittemore of this office will be the inspection team leader.

The objective of the inspection is to evaluate the effectiveness of your activities establishing baseline conditions to support compliance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.65. The inspection will be conducted using Inspection Procedure 62706, "Maintenance Rule." This inspection will involve a team of about six NRC personnel.

The inspection team will require information about your program and its implementation for their in-office preparation for the inspection. A description of the material that may be needed is provided in the enclosure to this letter. Mr. Whittemore will be contacting your staff to discuss the inspection plans in more detail and to arrange for specific material to be available to the team by January 6, 1997.
