NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Old Dominion Fabricators

License No. 45-15581-01

The following violation was identified during an inspection conducted on July 9, 1985. The Severity Level was assigned in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C).

10 CFR 71.12(b) requires that certain licensees, including radiographers who transport licensed material, have a quality assurance program approved by the Commission.

10 CFR 71.12(c)(1) requires that licensees, including radiographers who transport licensed material, have a Certificate of Compliance for package approval.

10 CFR 71.12(c)(3) requires that the licensee submit in writing, prior to the licensee's first use of the package, the licensee's name and license number and the package identification number specified in the package approval.

Contrary to the above, on July 9, 1985, the licensee had not complied with any of the requirements stated above.

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within 30 days of the date of this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) admission or denial of the alleged violations; (2) the reasons for the violations if admitted; (3) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (4) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (5) the date when full compliance will be achieved.

Security or safeguards information should be submitted as an enclosure to facilitate withholding it from public disclosure as required by 10 CFR 2.790(d) or 10 CFR 73.21.
