
Gentlemen:

This revision includes a plan change to describe the changes in security management at Maine Yankee.

Based on overall evaluation of the changes made to the Security Plan, it has been determined that the effectiveness of the Plan has not been decreased, therefore, the changes are being submitted under the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p).
