The license was issued in June 1984. Subsequently, VAX computers have undergone significant improvement. Improved VAX units have been incorporated in General Electric plant monitoring and display systems now being installed at reactor plant facilities.

This change makes it necessary to request the following amendment to the description of the equipment:

Plant monitoring and display system consisting of three VAX 8600's (5.5 mips), six micro-VAX's, one GEDAC (General Electric data acquisition and control) system with 13,500 data point capability at rates up to 400,000 samples per second and up to 20 display terminals per computer per plant and one VAX 8600 for the plant training simulator.


