
Mr. Madera:

Effective immediately, Diagnostic Reagents of Michigan will no longer be receiving or shipping radioactive materials (I^{125}) in the form of medical test kits. Therefore, I wish to cancel or withdraw our distributor license #23-19345-016.

No radioactive by-product materials have ever been used on the premises and no kits have ever been opened on-site. While acting as a distributor, the maximum total possession was 200 uCi of I^{125} (25 completed kits) with the daily ending inventory ranging between 1 and 10 kits. In the month of July, the average daily ending inventory was 4 kits.

A close-out survey was performed and no residual activity was found. (Copy enclosed)

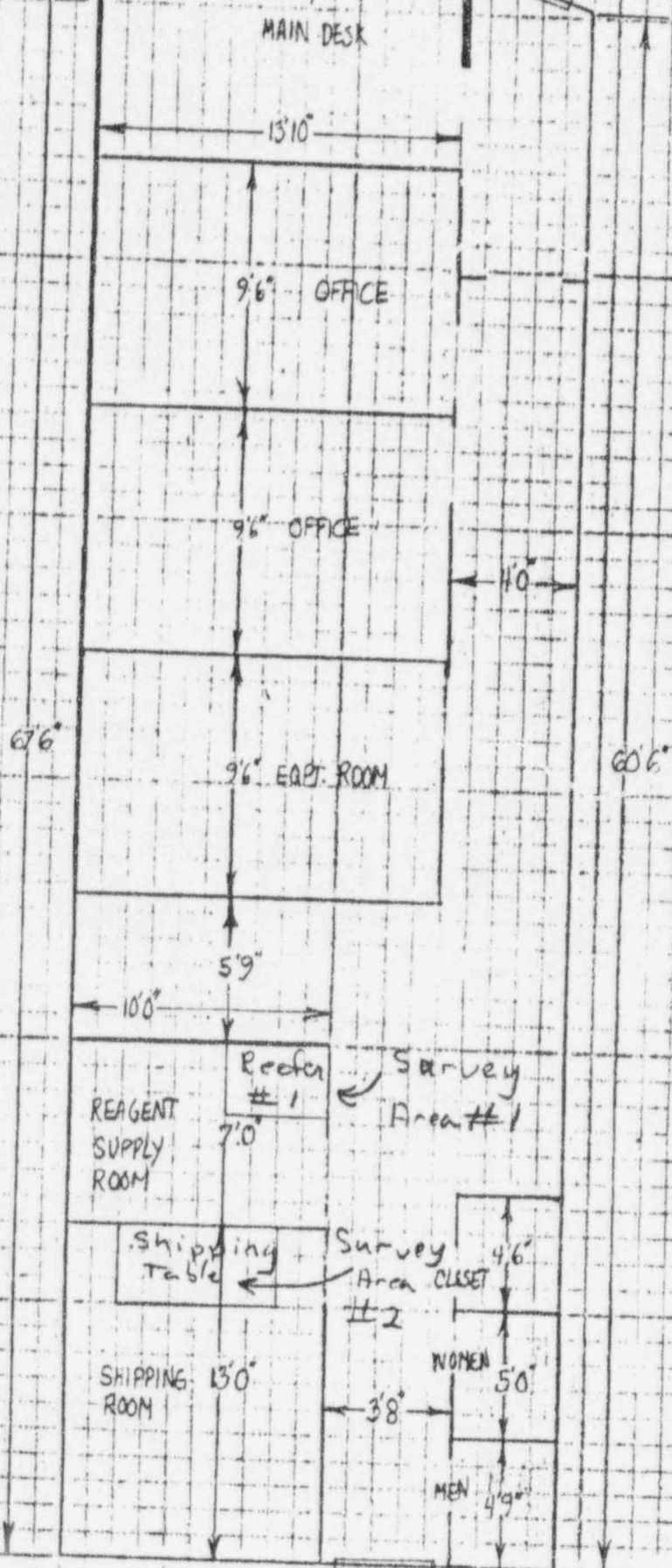

Mike,

You're right, Headquarters will draft either one of two actions. The first action is a withdrawal letter to the licensee indicating that we are withdrawing our CP and SL III violation. The second action is a settlement agreement, wherein we would request that he not be involved in licensed activities for a certain period of time, normally 3-5 years, and in return we would not enforce the CP or the Violation.

I just talked with OE today, and Lieberman has not yet decided on what direction he wants to go. Can we hold off issuing the termination of his license until Liebermann decides?

Regarding the withdrawal of License #23-19345-016, there is no radioactive material remaining on the premises of Diagnostic Reagents. All remaining by-product material in the form of completed and sealed medical kits was shipped to licensed medical facilities prior to withdrawal of our license. We have not "transferred" any other type of radioactive material to any other location. Any kits received prior to October 3, 1996 were received complete and unopened and were shipped prior to October 3, 1996 complete and unopened.

To repeat my statement from my letter of October 3, 1996, I personally performed a close-out survey. There is no residual activity and no by-product material on the premises.
