Dear Mr. Huber:

This is the final response to your letter dated March 18, 1985, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) the licenses, applications, and all supporting documentation and backup material for Radiation Safety Services' license 12-20424-01 and Illinois Department of Nuclear Safety's license 12-20084-01.

Portions of the documents listed on Appendix C have been deleted in order to withhold home addresses, telephone numbers, and other personal information. Because disclosure of this information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, it is being withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Exemption (6) of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(6)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(6) of the Commission's regulations. Copies of the released versions of the documents are enclosed.

The charge for reproducing records not located in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR) is five cents (\$0.05) per page, as specified in 10 CFR 9.14(b). Accordingly, the cost of reproducing the enclosed 180 pages is \$8.50. You will be billed by our Division of Accounting and Finance for the total amount of pages reproduced.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 9.9 of the Commission's regulations, it has been determined that the information withheld is exempt from production or disclosure, and that its production or disclosure is contrary to the public interest. The persons responsible for this denial are the undersigned and Mr. James G. Keppler, Administrator, Region III.

This denial may be appealed to the Commission's Executive Director for Operations within 30 days from the receipt of this letter. As provided in 10 CFR 9.11, any such appeal must be in writing, addressed to the Executive Director for Operations, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555, and should clearly state on the envelope and in the letter that it is an "Appeal from an Initial FOIA Decision."


