

TELEPHONE CONVERSATION WITH J. M. MENEFEE,  
HARSHAW CHEMICAL COMPANY, CLEVELAND, OHIO,  
IN REGARD TO CONTROL NUMBER 77294

Mr. Menefee requested that a separate license be issued for the tritium chromatography cell because the cell will be used by a group outside of Harshaw's Crystal-Solid State Division, which is the only division using material identified on License No. 34-6558-5. Menefee stated that within a year the Crystal-Solid State Division, including all their operations at the locations identified in Condition 11 of License No. 34-6558-5, will move to Solon, Ohio. At that time, it would be difficult to control the use of the tritium cell by another division in Cleveland.
