SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION AND NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Witzig:

This refers to the inspection conducted on September 16, 18, 19, and 20, 1996 at the Evansville, Terra Haute, Lafayette and Indianapolis, Indiana facilities, respectively. The purpose of the inspection was to determine whether activities authorized by the license were conducted safely and in accordance with NRC requirements. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with members of your staff. This also refers to telephone conversations with you through November 1, 1996.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, independent measurements and observation of activities in progress.

Based on the results of this inspection, the NRC has determined that violations of NRC requirements occurred. These violations are cited in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice). A written response is required.

As discussed with you on November 1, 1996, the NRC is continuing to review your dosimetry program for compliance with License Number 13-18685-01 and NRC regulations. Therefore, we consider this matter an unresolved item. We are withholding the issuance of our inspection findings regarding this item until we have completed our review. We will provide you with the results of our findings on this item in a separate correspondence.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter, the enclosure, and your response to this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document
