On December 20, 1968, Mr. Gerry Sinke, RSO of American Potash and Chemical Company, informed me that they had a potential contract with Gulf General Atomics concerning the drying out of 2,000 kilograms of thorium oxide which contained less than 0.1 percent of enriched uranium. He stated that this would represent about 2.3 kilograms of enriched uranium. He said he did not know what the uranium isotope was.

Mr. Sinke asked if they needed a special license to handle this contract.

Mr. Sinke was informed that he should contact DML at Headquarters for a specific answer to this question.

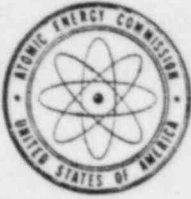
