We note from the application that the intention of the consignee is to manufacture ceramic stains and that a portion of the product will be sold to U. S. customers.

As you know, due to radiation safety considerations, the Atomic Energy Commission is presently limiting the use of uranium as a coloring agent in ceramic products manufactured in the United States.

Accordingly, before we may further consider your request for export license, we require the following information regarding the products that are to be distributed in the United States:

1. An identification of the product, including the percentage of uranium used in the product.
2. The contact dose rate (beta, and beta plus gamma) of the finished product (listing the type of radiation survey instrument used).
