We have received a copy of your August 11 letter to Mr. A. H. Reesor Smith, P. Engineer, Toronto, Canada, regarding his request for a license to purchase thorium-containing catalyst from The Harshaw Chemical Company.

It was our understanding that industrial users of thorium-containing catalyst apply directly to the Atomic Energy Commission for a license. Since the proper procedure, according to your letter, is for Harshaw to apply for an export license, will you please grant us a license to export 5 pounds of a catalyst containing 10% ThO<sub>2</sub> to Mr. A. H. Reesor Smith of Toronto, Canada? Probably a six month license would be sufficient.
