Attached for your concurrence is a Part 2 letter to the subject licensee.

We are not citing the subject licensee for noncompliance with License Condition No. 16, for failing to leak test two 10 microcurie cesium 137 sealed sources, one 5 microcurie cobalt 60 sealed source and one 20 microcurie iridium 192 sealed source, for the reasons set forth in Inspection Guide Memo No. 48.

Also, we have not cited the licensee for failing to leak test the plated polonium 210 and americium 241 sources since the license no longer requires that these sources be leak tested. We do not consider these plated sources to be sealed.

These matters were discussed with Tom Brockett on July 23, 1962.
