Dear Ms. Holt:

Recently, our laboratory received an invoice from the NRC to continue our Specific License (copy of invoice enclosed). The only radioactive materials utilized at our laboratory are three Hewlett Packard ⁶³Ni Electron Capture Detectors (ECD) for Hewlett Packard gas chromatographs.

I was informed by Mr. Michael Webber of your office that the Hewlett Packard ECDs that we have installed are under NRC General License. The three ECD systems are:

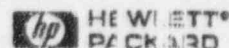
