

Per our telephone conversation the following are highlights of my telephone conversation with a former Harshaw Chemical Company employee (Paul Mining) regarding the use of depleted uranium at the plant:

- The depleted uranium was to be used in Ceramic pigments.
- The material was purchased from Davidson.
- One drum arrived at the Plant. When our employees saw the radioactive label, they raised such a furor that the plant decided to discontinue the project.
- The one drum was shipped back to Davidson within a few days without having been opened.
- In reality the Plant had no intention to process the material but rather only re-sell it.
