SUBJECT: INFORMATION MEETING ON THE REMEDIATION OF SEQUOYAH FUELS FACILITY
IN SEQUOYAH COUNTY, OKLAHOMA

Dear Mr. Ellis:

This letter is to invite you, as a representative of Sequoyah Fuels Corporation, to the fourth in a series of meetings to share information concerning the decommissioning of Sequoyah Fuels Corporation (SFC) facility. The meeting will be held on Tuesday, February 25, 1997, at the Webbers Falls City Hall from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. The meeting will be facilitated by F. X. Cameron, Special Counsel for Public Liaison at the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission. A list of invited representatives is enclosed.

The purpose of this meeting is to share information concerning the status of SFC decommissioning with representative stakeholders and the public. This includes current site characterization and decommissioning activities at the facility, projected schedules and plans for the remediation of the site, and the roles of the NRC and other regulatory agencies in the remediation. We invite you to participate by representing your organization with representatives from the NRC, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region VI, Sequoyah Fuels Corporation, local officials, and citizen groups. As a representative, you may participate in a facilitated round-table discussion where you will be asked to present information and views on upcoming actions concerning the remediation of the SFC facility. An agenda for each meeting will be prepared and distributed to all invited representatives; a draft is enclosed for your information as well as placed in the local public document room in advance of the meeting. The public will be present at the meeting, and time will be provided for public comment during the meeting. Comments and questions will generally be directed to topics contained in the agenda, and will be limited to the remediation of the SFC facility. Future Information Meetings will be held periodically to address other issues related to the remediation of the SFC facility.

The Information Meetings are not intended to serve as a substitute for the existing process for the public review of regulatory documents and decisions on site remediation. Rather, the meetings are to serve as an open forum to help keep affected stakeholders and the public informed about plans, schedules and important issues related to the remediation of the SFC facility.

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
