

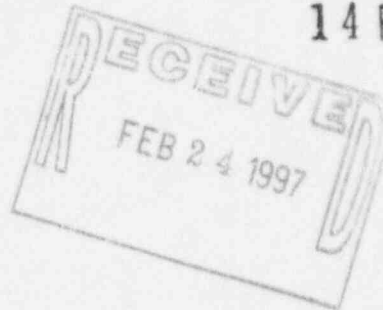

SUBJECT: Corrective Actions Report, USAF Radioactive Material Permit 33-30527-1AFP (Your Memo, 22 Jan 97)

1. We have reviewed your corrective actions for the deficiencies identified during the radioactive material permit compliance inspection conducted 29 Oct 96. Except as noted below, we find the actions appear to be appropriate to preclude recurrence of the violations.

2. We request additional information as necessary to clarify the following open issues:

a. Ref Item #2. The copy of the inventory record you submitted does not contain all the information required by AFI 40-201, *Managing Radioactive Materials in the USAF*, paragraph 3.6.3. Specifically, the record does not contain the identity of the source radionuclide and quantity or the location of each source. In addition, it is ambiguous whether the signature in the "Inventory Conducted By" column is intended to satisfy the requirement that the radiation safety officer sign and certify the accuracy of the inventory. Also, it appears that the dates in the "Next Scheduled Inventory" column should indicate 1997.

b. Ref Item #3. The radiation safety officer appointment letter you submitted appears to include an individual who does not meet the requirements to be named as alternate radiation safety officer. The alternate radiation safety officer must meet the same requirements as the primary radiation safety officer. Review the requirements for radiation safety officer in Condition 14 of your permit and provide documentation that the named individual meets those requirements. Also, include documentation to demonstrate that the primary radiation safety officer completed the Lead Inspector Training course as anticipated.

3. Request you respond to the items addressed above NLT 30 days from the date of this memorandum. Send your response directly to HQ AFIA/SG.

4. Although Item #4 in your original response is still open with an estimated completion date, your planned actions are reasonable and appropriate and you do not need to make a 90-day resubmission as required in the inspection report.
