The Harshaw Chemical Company recently received license number C-4284 allowing us to purchase 100 pounds of Depleted uranium oxide and 25 pounds of depleted uranium tetrafluoride for Ceramic and Glass Decorating work. Harshaw now wishes to purchase truckload quantities of these depleted uranium salts to enable us to stock moderate quantities of black uranium oxide and uranium tetrafluoride at our own warehouses in Los Angeles, Cleveland and/or Elyria, Philadelphia, and Pittsburgh. This would enable us to send out our own products directly to the customer and relieve Davison Chemical Company from this detail. Would you please inform us as to the formalities that we must observe to stock these quantities? Do our customers need a license to buy from us? How close an inventory must we keep on such a stockpile? We would appreciate a prompt answer to our questions and any forms which may be necessary to obtain a new license for this work.
