Enclosed is a copy of a letter from Mr. Ahmed at St. Joseph Hospital, Chicago, Illinois regarding their request concerning a medical emergency therapy with Cs-137 sources, which needs to be performed at our hospital as soon as possible.

We request amendment to our license to permit these therapies to be done on a routine basis, as needed, by Drs. Ameen and Kim of St. Joseph Hospital. Since there is no receiving of these sources by our hospital personnel and there is no storage area (other than the patient temporarily containing the sources), I believe Mr. Ahmed has provided most of the pertinent information. The accountability of the sources, as well as the radiation safety procedures and nursing instructions for brachytherapy patients, will also be maintained by the radiotherapists or their physicists, as they do at St. Joseph Hospital.

Enclosed is our check for \$120 for the amendment processing fee. Thank you for your assistance in expediting this request.
