This refers to our phone conversation of today regarding the transfer and return of sealed Cesium 137 sources. Additional information is as follows:


1. The sources will be transferred from St. Joseph Hospital to Ravenswood Hospital (lic. #12-09675-01) for therapy.
2. Total strength of the sources used by the therapists is between 40 to 80 mg. Ra. Eqv.
3. Manufacturer of the sources used by the therapists is 3M Co. and their model # is 6D6C-CA.
4. At the end of therapy all sources will be brought back to St. Joseph Hospital.
5. Drs. Ameen and Kim are both authorized users of Cesium 137 sources at St. Joseph Hospital and Ravenswood Hospital.
6. Sources will be transferred and returned to St. Joseph Hospital by Dr. Kim in his car.

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7. Sources will be carried in lead container and secured in the trunk of the car.
8. The trunk will always be locked.
9. A log on removal and return of sources to St. Joseph Hospital will be maintained.

There is a medical emergency at Ravenswood Hospital and the patient needs treatment with Cesium sources at an early date, preferably during the 2nd week of this month. Therefore, it is requested that permission be granted as soon as possible.
