Gentlemen:

In response to your September 20, 1983 letter requesting amendment of NRC License Number 12-04933-04G, we sent you a letter, dated August 8, 1985, and held a meeting between Messrs. Marty Simonin and Stan Huber, of your organization, and me on August 12, 1985.

As discussed in the meeting, your NRC License Number 12-04933-06G already authorizes you to distribute iodine-129 in the calibration trays and rod sources specified in your May 22, 1984 letter to the NRC. However, as stated in our August 8, 1985 letter, each tray or source must be labeled as stated in your May 22, 1984 letter, cannot exceed the exempt quantity specified in Section 30.71, Schedule B of 10 CFR Part 30 and must be packaged in accordance with Section 32.19 of 10 CFR Part 32. If you desire to distribute trays or rod sources with different construction or labeling than specified in your May 22, 1984 letter, you will need to request an amendment of your NRC License Number 12-04933-06E as described in Options 1 and 2 of our August 8, 1985 letter.

It is our understanding that you desire to distribute the trays or sources as separate items and not in a device as defined in Section 31.5 of 10 CFR Part 31. Consequently, you wish to withdraw your request to amend License Number 12-04933-04G.
