

July 1, 1996 to December 31, 1996

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Management Action:

- ♦ In December, the new Generation Support Building was completed at River Bend supporting permanent housing of departments on site. The Access Authorization Department and the Fitness for Duty Department will be housed in Main Admin II. Access Authorization completed its transition to MA-II in December. The final phase of construction for the Fitness for Duty Department is nearing completion. The expected date of relocating should be mid-March. This permanent housing will place the two departments together, expediting processing time and ending our tenure in trailers.

Fitness for Duty Initiatives Taken:

- ♦ The Random Drug Testing Rate at River Bend Station for July 1, 1996 through December 31, 1996 is currently 52.7%.
- ♦ In September, members from River Bend's Fitness for Duty Department and Access Authorization Department traveled to Grand Gulf Nuclear Power Station to assist in testing and in-processing of personnel
- ♦ The new computer based random selection system that was implemented in June has been efficient during this period. The new system saves time as well as allows for fewer mistakes by minimizing the amount of individuals entering data.

Effectiveness Evaluation:

- ♦ The Fitness for Duty Section will continue to update and revise Fitness for Duty Procedures based on operating experiences, lessons learned and NRC Audits conducted at other Nuclear sites.
