Withdrawal of License Amendment Requests
Jet Pumps and Feedwater Coolant Injection Subsystem

The purpose of this letter is for Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) to request the withdrawal of two license amendment requests currently being reviewed by the NRC Staff.

In a letter dated July 28, 1994,⁽¹⁾ as amended on October 2, 1995,⁽²⁾ NNECO submitted a license amendment request for Millstone Unit No. 1. The request proposed a revision to the Millstone Unit No. 1 Technical Specification 3.5.C which would allow the feedwater coolant injection (FWCI) system to be downgraded from its seismic Category I status. NNECO has since elected to maintain the FWCI system as a seismic Category I system. As such, a license amendment is no longer required, and NNECO hereby withdraws the license amendment request dated July 28, 1994.

On a second issue, in a letter dated November 8, 1995,⁽³⁾ NNECO submitted a license amendment request relating to Millstone Unit No. 1 Technical Specification 3/4.6.G. This license amendment would make the surveillance of jet pump operability consistent with the industry standard guidance, as found in NUREG 1433, "Standard Technical Specifications - General Electric Plants, BWR/4." As a result of further review, NNECO
