Gentlemen:

We have reviewed your letter dated May 24, 1985 requesting the addition of Group VI material to your byproduct materials license and find that we will need additional information as follows:

1. Your source accountability program should be strengthened. In order to accomplish this, you should either provide the following or else develop and submit equivalent alternatives:
 - a. Designate one individual as source custodian and develop a procedure to ensure that all sources are ordered, received, stored, dispensed and returned to storage after treatment through this individual.
 - b. Develop and submit a running inventory from which lists all sources by nuclide, type (seed, etc.) and number on hand. Space should be provided for the source custodian to indicate the number in storage, number checked out for treatment, number returned and number remaining each time a source is removed for use or returned.
 - c. Develop and submit specific procedures to ensure compliance with 10 CFR 35.14(b)(5)(vii), enclosed.
 - d. Develop a schedule for periodic inventories (e.g., monthly) to compare the actual source count to the running inventory.
2. Please submit a detailed description of where the sealed sources will be stored including a description of the shielding and anticipated radiation levels in surrounding unrestricted areas with a full complement of sources in the storage area.
3. Please specify a possession limit for all your Group VI materials.

We will continue our review of your application upon receipt of this information. Please reply in duplicate, within 30 days, and refer to Control Number 79208.
