9. Authorized Use

A. and B. For use in Campbell Pacific Nuclear Model MC Series moisture/density gauges.

Conditions 10., 12 and 17. are amended to read:

10. Licensed material may be used at 349 Mid Rivers Drive, St. Peters, Missouri and at temporary job sites of the licensee anywhere in the United States where the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of licensed material.

12. A. Licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision and in the physical presence of, individuals who have satisfactorily completed the device manufacturer's training program for gauge users and have been designated by the licensee's Radiation Protection Officer. The licensee shall maintain records of the individuals who have been designated as authorized users.

B. The Radiation Protection Officer for the activities authorized by this license is Theodore R. Reitz.

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17. Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use licensed material described in Items 6, 7, and 8 of this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in application dated April 11, 1980; and letters dated August 27, 1980 and August 20, 1985. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters, unless the statements are more restrictive than the regulations.
