Mr. D.G. Wiedeman:

This letter refers to your notice of violation dated August 2, 1985. Please accept our action taken of these violations in our attempt to achieve full competence.

Violation #1 Radiation Safety Committee Meetings.

1. The Radiation Safety Committee met on July 29, 1985.
2. The committee has planned to meet in October and December of 1985. To avoid further non-compliance.
3. In December of 1985 we will have met with compliance of the quarterly meetings.

Violation #2 Dose Calibrator Calibration

1. Our consultant agency has been notified and they will be here soon to correct the violation.
2. Corrective action will be achieved at time of calibration.
3. Full compliance will be achieved on or before September 30, 1985.

Violation #3 Radiation Exposure (Personnel Monitoring)

1. Corrective action was taken by contacting R.S. Landauer and was told the problem will be corrected as soon as possible.
2. To avoid further non-compliance, closer attention will be maintained of radiation exposure records.
3. The date of full compliance is difficult to determine at this time. The Radiation Safety Committee will be vigilant in its attempt to achieve full compliance before the next Radiation Safety Committee meeting.

Violation #4 Records of Licensed Material to Waste Disposal

1. Corrective action was taken immediately by recording the survey results and date of disposals.
2. Further compliance has been achieved by maintaining a record of waste disposal.
3. Full compliance has been achieved.

We hope our corrective action will meet with your approval and we assure you we will continue with our vigilant effort of full compliance of the rule and regulations of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.
