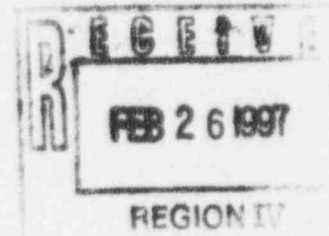

REPLY TO NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Violation: Failed to notify the USNRC Region IV Office in Arlington, Texas of the opening and closing of existing branch offices (within non-Agreement States) within 7 days. Specifically, the closing of the branch office at 2606 Crossroads Drive, Ardmore, Oklahoma in the spring of 1996 and the opening of the branch office at 1400 South Commerce, Ardmore, Oklahoma at the same time.

Reply to a Notice of Violation: (1.) The move from the smaller BJ Services yard at 2606 Crossroads to the larger (former Western Company of North America) yard at 1400 South Commerce was a gradual move that took place over a period of several months, due to renovations that were being made to the larger yard. After the move was completed I forgot that I had not notified the USNRC office in Arlington of the change of address for the Ardmore site. (2.) When I was reminded of my oversight by the Inspector during our telephonic exit briefing on January 21, 1997, I sent a letter to the USNRC Region IV Office in Arlington, Texas which contained a notice of change of address for the Ardmore location and gave the correct address as 1400 S. Commerce, Ardmore, OK 73401. My letter was dated January 29, 1997. (3.) I will make every effort not to forget such notifications in the future. (4.) Full compliance has been achieved as of February 24, 1997.
