Dear Mr. Harrison:

This letter refers to your December 19, 1996 correspondence, in response to our December 10, 1996 letter.

Thank you for informing us of the corrective and preventive actions documented in your letter in regard to Violation B. These actions will be examined during a future inspection of your licensed program.

Violation C has been rescinded based on the additional information you provided regarding a survey instrument calibration. In regard to Violation A you must request in writing that you wish to amend your license to name a new Radiation Safety Officer. At that time we will review your request and provide further instruction. The manufacturer may certify the transferable devices as general licensed devices at any time. However the NRC cannot terminate your specific license until you provide documentation that all specifically licensed devices have been properly disposed of. As a general licensee you will not need to name a Radiation Safety Officer and the manufacturer will provide you with instruction outlining your responsibilities as a general licensee.
