

We are requesting that our NRC License No. 24-06806-01 be amended to add Richard L. Cronemeyer, M.D., as an authorized user of Groups I, II, III, and IV, Xenon-133, in vitro studies, Iodine-131 for treatment of thyroid carcinoma, and Phosphorus-32 for localization of ocular tumors.

A letter from Dr. Ralph G. Robinson, professor of diagnostic radiology and head of the division of nuclear medicine at the University of Kansas, and Form NRC 313M, supplements A and B, are enclosed as documentation of Dr. Cronemeyer's training and experience.
