

Gentlemen:

Excelsior Springs City Hospital has elected to utilize the services of a mobile medical service. The purpose of this letter is to request that the license issued to Excelsior Springs City Hospital be terminated. We ask that this termination not be acted on until such time as Mediq Mobile Services amends their license to perform nuclear medicine studies at our facility. In conjunction with this portion of the request, we have sent Mediq Mobile Services a copy of this termination letter to be included with their amendment. The 200 uCi Cs-137 source, used for calibrating the dose calibrator, has been transferred to Medical Imaging, Inc., Parvin Medical Building, 2001 N.E. Parvin Road, Kansas City, Missouri, 64116, (Missouri License #24-24423-01). An NRC form 314 is attached showing how the material was disposed of.
