Dear Dr. William J. Adam:

I am writing you in response to your letter dated 7-18-85.

I will address the issues in part I of your letter.

It is our intent to be licensed for all the materials listed in 10CFR Part 35, Schedule 35.100 (f). We will follow appendix L of Regulatory Guide 10.8 for radiation safety procedures for therapeutic use of sealed sources. (see attached appendix L).

Concerning the strontium-90 eye applicator we will assure the following:

- A. We will survey Sr-90 applicators upon receipt in accordance with 10CFR 20.205. Use of a properly calibrated G.M. type survey meter will be on hand for use when the package arrives.
- B. The Sr-90 applicator will be kept in the Radiation Therapy Department at Good Samaritan Medical Center. It will be properly shielded in observance of good A.L.A.R.A. practices and will be kept in locked storage to prevent unauthorized removal. It will be kept in the manufacturers supplied storage case and no inserts will be removed.
- C. We will follow your "Enclosure 2" for rules concerning safe handling of Sr-90 eye applicator a copy of which is enclosed.

I hope that our responses to your inquiry are adequate and timely. Thank you for your guidance and assistance with the amendment.
