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REPORT OF PROPOSED ACTIVITIES IN NON-AGREEMENT STATES

Section 150.20 of 10 CFR 150 establishes a general license authorizing any person who holds a specific license from an "Agreement State" (a State with which the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission has entered into an effective agreement under subsection 274b of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954) where the licensee maintains an office for directing the licensed activity and at which radiation safety records are normally maintained, to conduct the same activity in "Non-Agreement States" if the specific license issued by the Agreement State does not limit the authorized activity to specified installations or locations.

INSTRUCTIONS

Submit this Form and the Agreement State specific license in quadruplicate at least 3 days prior to engaging in each activity permitted under the General License established by Sec. 150.20 of 10 CFR 150. Send to:

Director of the Atomic Energy Commission Regional Compliance Office listed in Appendix D of Part 20 of this chapter for the region in which the Agreement State that issued the specific license is located.

If the Licensee, after filing this report, proposes to conduct activities in non-Agreement States not specified in this report, an amended Form AEC-241 (Revised) should be filed with the Commission.

NOTE: ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED IN NON-AGREEMENT STATES UNDER THE GENERAL LICENSE ARE LIMITED TO A TOTAL OF 180 DAYS IN ANY CALENDAR YEAR.
