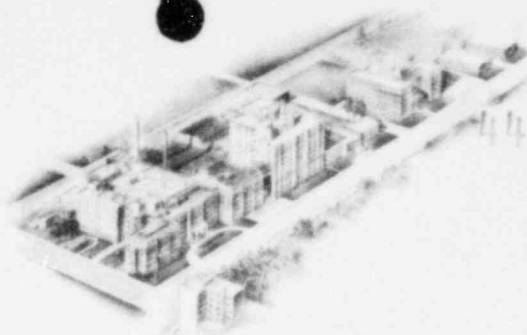

Dear Mr. Howell:

Since receiving Amendment No. 4 to our license, plans for our therapy wing have been changed. We are now going to make a separate building located in an area to the North of the area proposed in our application for this amendment.


The main difference will be one of orientation. In the new arrangement, the Cobalt room will be to the West of the Betatron room rather than to the East as originally shown. All occupancy factors and distances around this room will be the same as indicated on our application. All barrier calculations are the same with the exception that we changed the East wall requirements and the West wall requirements as follows:

1. East Wall -- thickness of this wall will be specified by the Betatron requirements which are estimated at a minimum of 1 meter of concrete.
2. West Wall -- will require 37 inches of concrete.

NOTE: Architect's drawings show one to two inches more concrete than that shown on our barrier calculations.
