In accordance with 10 C.F.R. § 30.37 and your notice of expiration dated July 13, 1983, Well Logging, Inc. hereby requests that its NRC Byproduct Material License No. 35-18229-01 be renewed, since Well Logging wishes to continue to operate under that license.

Well Logging's current program is accurately reflected in its original application dated July 27, 1978, as amended by letters dated August 18, 1978 and May 8, 1980 and applications dated June 24, 1981, August 19, 1981, and March 9, 1982 and letter dated May 10, 1982, with the following exception. Well Logging no longer stores a truck and associated equipment at the facility at 515 W. Cherry, Cushing, Oklahoma. The truck has been sold and the sealed source returned to the Well Logging facility on Highway 169, Nowata, Oklahoma. Condition 10 should be modified to reflect this change.

Well Logging will continue to operate in accordance with the documents identified above and with applicable NRC regulations and license conditions.
