Dear Sir:

The subject license expires January 31, 1962. It is our desire to have this license renewed for another year. The original application for this license was my letter of December 23, 1960.

Most conditions described in this letter remain the same. The following are exceptions:

1. Total quantity for the year will approximate 2,000 lbs. Thorium content instead of 1,000 lbs.
2. The maximum quantity on hand at one time will be 500 lbs. instead of 300 lbs. The material would be in the following form. (All cases are maximums):

Raw Material	300 lbs. of Thorium as Thorium Salt
Process	50 lbs. of Thorium
Semi-Finished Product	150 lbs. of Thorium
Finished Product	300 lbs. of Thorium

Please note that the above maximums are not additive.

3. The only change to facilities originally described will be a 20' x 20' of Thorium Compounds and Thoriated products.
