Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use licensed material described in Items 6, 7, and 8 of this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in application dated February 19, 1981; letters dated November 15, 1982 and September 11, 1985; and Model ALARA Program as contained in Appendix O of Regulatory Guide 10.8, October 1980. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters, unless the statements are more restrictive than the regulations.
