Pursuant to this request, please provide all documents prepared or utilized by, in the possession of, or routed through the NRC related to:


1. Analysis, review and preparation of the Safety Evaluation Report and Environmental Impact Statement for the operating license stage for the Vogtle Nuclear power plant, including all memoranda, correspondence and draft inputs.
