Gentlemen:

This is in reference to your application dated July 17, 1985 to amend your byproduct material license. In order to complete our review, we need the following additional information:

1. 10 CFR 20.203(c)2(iii) specifies that the entrance or access point to a high radiation area will be maintained locked except during periods when access is required.

You should specify how the shooting room will be secured.

2. Also, 10 CFR 20.203(c)(3) states that no one should be prevented from leaving a high radiation area.

You should describe the provisions which have been made to assure that personnel may leave the shooting room at any time.

3. With regard to the door, roof, and outside walls of the shooting room, please submit the following:

- a. Describe the expected maximum radiation level at the door of the shooting room. Include a description of the expected scatter contribution when the source is near the longest wall of the room. If the level exceeds 2 mr/hr, describe the steps which will be taken to reduce the radiation to this level.
- b. As the levels on the roof of the shooting room may be 25 mr/hr, there should be no ladders, stairwells, or other means of access to the room. You should describe any means of access to this roof. Also, describe the maximum level which will be allowed there. State the steps which will be taken to assure that this limit will not be exceeded.

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- c. Submit the procedures which will be given to personnel to ensure that no one may gain access to the shooting room roof during the performance of radiography.
- d. You should confirm that the radiation levels at the outside wall surfaces of the shooting room will not, for any allowable radiography procedure, exceed 2 mr/hr.

We will continue the review of your amendment request upon receipt of this information. If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter, we shall assume that you do not wish to pursue your application. Please reply in duplicate, and refer to Mail Control No. 70231.
